French

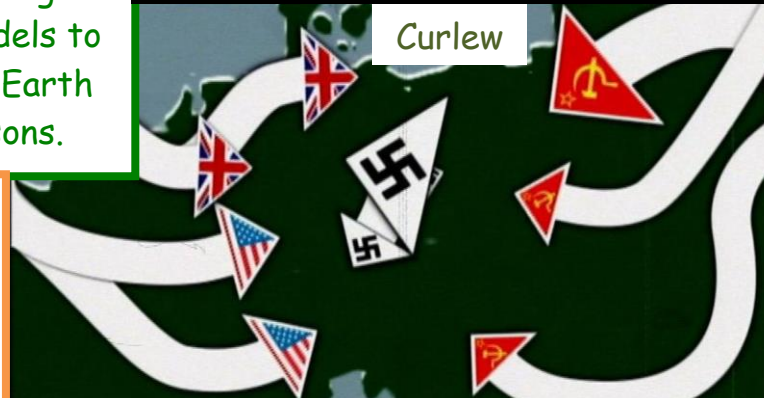
We will be learning to say which hobbies we like and dislike.
