### <u>Art/DT</u>

Here the children will learn about the artist Peter Thorpe and a range of digital artists. They will develop and create their own digital picture and painting on a theme, inspired by the work of these artists.

The children will also explore colour mixing and use their sketch books to record and develop ideas.

The class will also design and build a moving vehicle with a range of tools and materials and evaluate their final product.

## <u>Humanities</u>

Children will learn about how transport has changed over time and how this has had a significant impact on the way people live their lives.

The children will also find out about the lives of significant people, such as explorers and inventors.


The class will also find out about different locations around the world and decide where they would like to go and say why.

### <u>French</u>

In this unit of work Lapwing Class will learn about pets and the names of different animals. They will also be talking about brothers and sisters.

# <u>PE</u>

In this 'Striking and Fielding' unit, children will learn skills needed to play games, such as cricket and rounders. They will learn how to catch and throw across different distances with accuracy. They will develop their skills of cooperation and tactics.

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## <u>PSHEE</u>

In PSHE this term the children will be learning about what we need to do stay healthy. They will be encouraged to consider healthy choices they can make, thinking about what we eat and drink and how we can ensure we are getting sufficient exercise in our daily lives.

Children will also be learning about money, why we have it, what we can do with it and how people earn it.

#### <u>Music</u>

This term, children will continue to learn using the Charanga programme, exploring the theme of **Friendship**. They will use their voices and percussion instrument and listen to and learn songs from a range of genres.

## <u>Science</u>

Our topic this term is 'Light'. In this unit of work, children will learn through a range of enquiry lead investigations. They will learn that we need light to see things and that dark is an absence of light. The children will investigate how light is reflected from different surfaces and that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object. The class will also discover that the light from the sun can be dangerous and will consider ways to keep themselves safe, such as ways to protect their eyes.

# <u>RE</u>

Our topic this term is What does it mean to belong to a community? Here, the children will explore what it means to be part of a community. They will discover some of the ways people express their membership of communities and discuss the benefits of being a part of a community.
