

English

In English we will be looking at creating stories, based on our reading book 'The Explorer'. We will also be looking at information texts and descriptive writing using more advanced language and punctuation.

Art

The class will be completing the Sycamore Gap sculpture project we started in July, as well as working on a project linked to the Amazon Rainforest.

ICT

In ICT we will use different devices to carry out research and using video and audio recordings to create a short animated film about the Amazon Rainforest.

Science

In Science we will be looking at properties of materials. We will be aiming to carry out a range of experiments to improve our investigation skills.

PE

We will be learning offensive and defensive tactics and skills to support tag rugby matches.



French

We will be working on introductions and conversations.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at the Amazon rainforest. This will include how the rainforest is structured, the plants, animals and humans that live there and the threats the rainforest are facing.
