

Art

We will be learning to draw Egyptian hieroglyphs and using these to design cartouches, before decorating them with primary and secondary colours.

We will also paint moon and sun pictures in warm and cool shades.

English

We will be reading our class novel 'Secrets of a Sun King'. Using this as inspiration, we will be writing newspaper reports about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb. We will also be practising reciting a narrative poem.

DT

We will be creating canopic jars from clay. Once fired, we will paint them in traditional colours.

Computing

We will be using the programme Logo to learn how to code a series of instructions.

Science

We will be studying how different living things are adapted to survive. We will learn about food chains and the role of predators and prey. We will consider different habitats around the world, with a particular focus on the living things adapted to live locally to us.

French

We will be learning how to order food and drink in a café.

PE

In Games, we will be learning how to play the net games of badminton and volleyball. In Movement, we will develop our gymnastics skills, before learning a class dance routine.

PSHE

We will be learning about how to work as part of a team and overcome challenges together.

Geography

We will be recapping the continents of the world, before focussing on Egypt's location within Africa. We will study the importance of the River Nile in the development of Egyptian settlements, and how in ancient times they used the river in their daily lives.
