

### English

We will be reading a novel set in Egypt, as well as writing non-chronological reports about Ancient Egypt. We will continue to learn grammatical rules and devices to improve our writing.

### Science

We will be looking at Adaptations of Living Things. This includes studying fossils, local and African animal features, looking for plant adaptations around us and studying the palaeontologist Mary Anning.

### RE

We will tackle two main questions this term: 'How and why do people mark the significant events of life?' and 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?'

### Art and D.T.

We will be making Egyptian canopic jars and mummies. We will learn to draw hieroglyphics and create cartouches. The class will build a sarcophagus to store our mummies in!

We will be using 'Scratch' to code our own quizzes. We will also explore the themes of online reputation, privacy and security.
