

Our Amazing Earth

Summer Term

English

In English we will create pieces of work around our theme of 'Our Amazing Earth'. We will look at persuasive writing (including adverts and letter writing) and discussion text in more detail. We will also be creating information reports linked to our topic work. We will also continue to develop our SPaG and Reading skills ahead of the end of year assessments.

Science

In Science we will be exploring the adaptation of living things. This will include looking at how different living things are classified, how to use keys and branching diagrams to identify different species and looking at how different living things are adapted to their environments. This topic will involve developing their field work and investigation skills to apply their knowledge in outdoor learning.

Geography

Through our topic work we will be aiming to develop a range of geographical skills. This will include using a range of maps to examine different locations, planning journeys to different countries and examining different cultures. We will be collecting information and measurements about the world around us and looking at different ways to display this information effectively.

Art and Design

We will be working on a number of projects this term for display at the Forge and local shows. This will include exploring multicultural art, sketching techniques and turning 2D designs into 3D structures. We will also be taking part in a number of workshops, including a workshop exploring fabric art and another looking at photography and developing photos.

RE

In RE this year, children will investigate a number of questions that will enable them to explore a range of religious and non-religious beliefs. They will develop their understanding of the impact of these beliefs on people's lives and then make connections between the beliefs held by different religious and non-religious groups. This term focuses on 'What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?' and 'Creation and Science- Conflicting or complimentary?'

ICT

ICT this term will include a focus on developing our coding skills using a range of programs, including Scratch. We will also look at developing our multi-media skills, including video editing and animations.

PE

In PE we will be completing units on cricket and rounders, including developing throwing and catching skills, as well as working on tactics and sportsmanship. We will also be working on athletics ahead of summer competitions, including practicing both track and field events.

French

Mrs Mason will be continuing to teach French, focusing on conversational skills and expanding their vocabulary by looking at a range of areas.

PSHEE

PSHEE this term will focus on how to form healthy relationships (including online behaviour), with strong links to transition, developing independence and changes as we grow up.

Music

This term Music will be focused on preparing for taking part in the Big Gig. We will be exploring popular songs from the 1980s and developing our performance skills.
