

English

In English we will be reading an adaptation of a Sherlock Holmes mystery, as well as creating pieces of writing inspired by Victorian poets, artists, scientists and other historical figures.

Science

In Science we will be looking at forces. We will learn about Sir Isaac Newton and put a number of his principles into action. Pupils will conduct experiments to put these to the test.

RE

We will tackle two main questions this term: how does faith help people when life gets hard and, in the lead up to Easter, what do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people.

D.T.

We will be creating communication devices, blending Morse code with electrical circuitry, to send messages between buildings. We will also use micro:bits to upgrade these.

ICT

We will learn to program BBC Micro:bits to act in different ways, including a step-counter, night light and LED name badge. We will also use 'Scratch' for coding.

PE

We will be devising our own ten-part gymnastics sequences using a mixture of equipment. We will set our own criteria for judging these.

French

We will learn about the role of gender in the French language.

Topic

This term, we will be looking at Victorian Britain: their inventions, conquests, social progress and problems. We will learn about inspiring figures like Emmeline Pankhurst and Florence Nightingale.

We will be focussing on how friends can communicate safely.
