We will be learning to print a repeated design in different colours to create work inspired by Andy Warhol. We will be using different materials to carve printing stencils for work inspired by Katsushiki Hokusai.

English

We will be reading our class novel 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter', along with a range of short versions of Shakespeare plays. Using these as inspiration, we will be writing short adventure stories and playscripts. We will also rehearse and perform our scripted dramas.

DT

We will be creating 3D models of volcanoes and fault zones, identifying their different features and contours.

Computing

We will be learning how to create, edit and use video to present our ideas to different audiences.

Science

We will be studying how sound is produced through vibrations and how it travels to the human ear. We will be learning about how light travels in straight lines from light sources to our eyes. We will investigate different properties of sound and light, including pitch, volume, brightness and shadow.



PE

In Games, we will be learning how to play the striking-fielding games of rounders and cricket. In Movement, we will develop our athletics skills, as well as attending weekly swimming lessons.

Geography
