We will be creating our own rangoli patterns using different materials and colours. We will use two-point perspective to draw a version of the famous Taj Mahal.

### English

We will be reading our class novel 'Asha and the Spirit Bird'. Using this as inspiration, we will be writing letters between characters, descriptions of different places, and information texts about Indian festivals.

### DT

We will be learning textiles and cookery skills, inspired by Indian clothing and cuisine.

### Computing

We will be using digital programmes to capture and edit photographs.

### Science

We will be studying the life cycles of different animals and plants. We will learn about some of the changes that humans go through as we grow up. We will carry out a range of practical activities to develop our classification and investigation skills.

### French

### PE
